Each academic year includes two payment concepts: Reservation and Tuition. The reservation fee includes student insurance.

Reservation Fee

The total amount of the reservation fee for the 2027/2028 course is €2,100. First year students must also pay the administration fee of €500 (one-time payment on their first year).

Tuition Fee

This amount is calculated by multiplying the price of the credit of the chosen Undergraduate program by the number of credits enrolled. In the first year, it will be mandatory to enrol the 60 ECTS corresponding to the full course. This amount can be paid in the following ways:

- In a single payment, between September 1st and 5th, with a bonus discount of 3%.
- In 10 monthly instalments, from September to June, due on the 5th of each month.

UDIT will refund the amount paid for the reservation and tuition fees only when the student certifies, by means of an official document, that he or she does not meet the legal requirements for access to the university in the chosen degree.

The instalment plan is available exclusively to students from Latin America, Brazil, and Europe. Students from other regions are required to pay the full tuition before the start of the course no later than July. Beginning in the second year, a payment plan will also be available to these students.
